

# ATTRACTIONS

## Pioneer Park

Pioneer Park runs adjacent to the railway line with barbecue facilities, picnic tables, 24 hour disabled toilets and a small playground area for small children for public use. Many of the old buildings in Pingelly are made from mud bricks which were taken from this location.

## Boyagin Rock Nature Reserve

Situated 26km north-west of Pingelly off the Great Southern Highway, Boyagin Rock is a favourite picnic area and especially scenic during spring. It is one of the last preserves of the native wildlife and plants which once dominated the area. Barbecue and picnic facilities are available. Look for the signs.

## Tutanning Flora and Fauna Reserve

The Tutanning Flora and Fauna Reserve is located 22.5km east of Pingelly off the Wickepin-Pingelly Road. It is renowned for wildflowers and native animals. Look for the signs.

## Moorumbine

Moorumbine, situated 8km east of Pingelly off the Wickepin-Pingelly Road, is a small townsite settled in 1864. The "Moorumbine Heritage Trail" is a short walk or drive through the old townsite and features many sites of historical significance including the early settler's cottage and St Patrick's Church of England which was consecrated in 1873 and is still in use today.

## Tianco Emu Farm

Tianco Emu Farm is situated on the eastside of town on Harper Street. Flocks of emus and kangaroos can be seen from the roadside.



## The Cross

Situated on private property on the east side of town, the Cross stands 15m high and is illuminated at night. The Cross was built by a local farmer as a symbol of peace and hope.

## Pingelly Heights Observatory

'Sunarise' Lot 11 Pingelly Heights.

## Apex Lookout

Located at Balfour Street, climb to the top of Apex Lookout and view Pingelly at a 360° degree panoramic view.

## Hotham Way

Golden Grain to Coastal Plain. The Hotham River Way was essential to the Aboriginal people as camping grounds and places of significance. The tourist drive takes in the towns of Pingelly, Wandering, Boddington, Dwellingup and Pinjarra, taking in many attractions and scenery.

## Dryandra Woodlands

Approximately 50km from Pingelly, off the Wandering-Narrogin Road, Dryandra Woodland Village is set in 22,000 hectares of woodland, housing a large number of rare native mammals including the Numbat and Woylie. Accommodation available. Caretaker 9884 5231

## Brief History on our Town

The Pingelly area was first settled in 1846 when sheep herders took up leases around freshwater springs. Incomes were supplemented by cutting sandalwood, mallet bark for tanning leather and hunting kangaroo for meat and skins.

The first settlement was gazetted at Moorumbine in 1884, however when the Great Southern Railway was completed in 1889 between Beverley and Albany, it passed 10kms West of the town and a small settlement was established near the railway siding. This was known as Pingegully after the Aboriginal name "Pingeculling" meaning "small gully of water", but soon became known as Pingelly.

Pingelly was gazetted as a town in 1898. This developed as the major centre and Moorumbine township declined.
